- 1. Simplify the following expressions.
  - (a)  $(p \lor q) \land (\neg p \lor \neg q) \land \neg (p \leftrightarrow q)$
  - (b)  $((p \to \neg q) \land p) \to (p \to q)$
  - (c)  $(p \lor \neg q) \land (q \lor \neg r) \land (r \lor \neg p)$
- 2. Are the following arguments valid?
  - (a) If I eat that burger, I will get sick. If I don't eat the burger, the cook will be disappointed. Therefore, the cook will be disappointed if I don't get sick.

(b) Either I slept in or I showed up to work. If I showed up to work, my boss ignored me. My boss did not ignore me. Therefore, I must have slept in.
